Praise Ye the Lord

As believers we are privileged to draw near to the Almighty God anytime, anywhere and in any circumstance and offer praises and thanksgiving. Not only that we are privileged we are obligated to praise God always for who He is and what He has done for us. We can see a call or admonition to worship and praise God repeated many times, maybe much more than any other admonition, in the Scripture.

David was a great worshipper and he constantly praised God no matter what the situation. He said, "I will bless the Lord at all times and his praise shall continually be in my mouth." It was his deliberate decision to praise God all the time. Throughout the Psalms he gives plenty of reasons to praise God. He reflects on who God is, recounts the numerous blessings he has received from God and he could not stay quiet but praise God. When his wife Michal ridiculed him for dancing before the Ark of God, he said he will do anything before his God who placed him on the throne of Israel.

Give unto the Lord glory and strength. Give unto the Lord the glory due to His name. Psalm 29:1-2. We need to give glory to God according to the greatness of His Name. In the OT God required the animal for the sacrifice to be without any defect. Our sacrifice has to be without defect – coming out of a willing and thankful heart, not of compulsion and prompting but from love and gratefulness.

The Psalmist tells us when we come to worship together, even before we enter into the presence of God we must have praises and thanksgiving on our lips. "Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. **Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise.**"

May we together with David make a commitment to praise God all the time.

It is also a command in the New Testament. In Hebrews we read, "Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name". We ought to offer praise as a sacrifice whereby we openly confess the Name of Jesus. When we praise Him, sing His attributes, and proclaim the goodness of God we are acknowledging and affirming the power of the Name of Jesus. And this sacrifice has to be verbally expressed, not just to be meditated in our hearts.

Praise and thanksgiving are weapons that bring down the strongholds of the enemy and give us victory. When Paul and Silas were in the prison their prayer and singing hymns caused a violent earthquake

through which they were delivered. When King Jehoshaphat was attacked by a vast army of three kings he appointed men to sing and praise God. When they did so, God brought ambushes against the enemy. We overcome the enemy through our praises, the blood of Jesus and the confession of His Name.

And what do we do in heaven but continually praise Him? May it be that we praise God as surely as we breathe, and never be weary of offering our sacrifice of thanksgiving. No one is excluded for the Word of God says, **"Let everything that has breath praise the Lord."**
